

# Nick Adenhardt Memorial Scholarship 2023

## Administered by the Kernels Foundation

Nick Adenhardt was a bright young pitcher who played for the Cedar Rapids Kernels in 2006, and he was a rising star in the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim organization. Only hours after Nick's 2009 season debut on the mound for the Angels, he was tragically killed by a drunk driver on April 9, 2009, at age 22.

Nick's family would like to honor him by awarding a \$1,000 scholarship in his memory. The Kernels Foundation is privileged to administer the scholarship on behalf of Nick's family. The Kernels Foundation is also awarding a \$1,000 scholarship in Nick's memory.

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### Scholarship Requirements:

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior from an area public or private high school or home school
- Applicant must attend a two-year or four-year accredited college or university and take 12 or more hours per semester.
- Applicant must have played a school sport in the last two years.
- Applicant must be a great teammate.
- Applicant should have a clear vision of career goal.
- Applicant must demonstrate hard work and determination.

  - Sports coach or manager or teammate
  - School teacher or principal or counselor

All letters of recommendation **MUST BE SIGNED** and **MUST BE ON LETTERHEAD**.
